

## **Extracurricular Activity Eligibility**

The following rules shall govern participation in all school-approved extracurricular activities:

1. Participants must be enrolled in the district as full-time middle school students or high school students in courses that will earn three Carnegie units of credit per semester or enrolled in a nonpublic home-based program or an independent or parochial school taking an equivalent number of classes.
2. Students enrolled in the district must be in attendance at school for the last half of the school day in order to participate in any school-sponsored activity that is conducted on that day. In cases of emergency or extenuating circumstances, the principal or designee may grant an exception to this limitation. The attendance requirement will not apply to other students since the district cannot effectively monitor their daily attendance.
3. The principal shall develop a procedure for the distribution of a weekly ineligibility list, and for the period of time that students who are ineligible will not be eligible to participate. Students who receive one failing grade and/or two 'D's for the week will not be eligible to participate. A weekly 'warning' list shall be distributed in conjunction with the ineligibility list following the same procedure. Students must be listed on the 'warning' and/or ineligibility list for a minimum of one week before they will not be eligible to participate. No ineligibility lists will be published the first three weeks of each semester. No warning list will be published the first two weeks of each semester. The activities director and/or principal will certify individual student eligibility. Students participating in activities who are not enrolled in the district must provide appropriate certification stating that the academic eligibility requirements have been met.
4. Students must submit a physical examination statement to the school before participating in any sport.
5. Students must have emergency treatment, district parent permission and athletic insurance waiver forms, if applicable, filled out, signed and on file with the school before being allowed to practice in a sport or participate in any activity.
6. Students violating the district code of conduct, including the student activities contract, will be ineligible until they have complied with all disciplinary sanctions.

7. Repeated ineligibility during the season may, upon the decision of the principal, constitute permanent dismissal from the activity.
