As we plan for the next school year, we know there are many questions regarding the passage of the <u>Healthy School Meals for All program</u> (Proposition FF) in Colorado last November.

Custer County School District plans to participate in the Healthy School Meals for All program in School Year 2023-24

- o Starting next school year, all students will have access to reimbursable meals at their school at no cost.
  - o A la carte purchases will continue to be offered for a fee. The student may pay for the food items with cash.
- o We anticipate an increase in participation next school year. To ensure meal service runs efficiently, our focus is to:
  - o Ensure our kitchen sites are adequately staffed
  - o Make sure lunch lines move smoothly
  - o Examine lunch times so all students have enough time to eat

**PLEASE NOTE**: Federal funds will be paying for free meal status, whether your student qualifies through a state program or from income. State funds will be paying for the rest. To reduce the financial burden on the state, we will still ask your family to fill out a free and reduced lunch meal application at the beginning of the year.
